Footnotes

CHARLIEPRITTYANGEL broke readily to gain terms with a rival attending the pace under light rating racing into the bend, took over nearing the furlong marker and drew clear late under firm handling. COWGIRL JUSTICE tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight, moved to challenge three deep in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors late. EILEEN EVELYN settled in last near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out splitting foes to race five wide into upper stretch and made some belated progress in that path to edge a rival for a share. COOL GRETA ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted, sped to the fore along the rail racing to the turn, dueled for command inside the winner to upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong. DOLLY PEACH tracked off the second flight under some reserve near the inside in the opening stages, angled out four wide in upper stretch but lacked closing response. GUAVA GIRL tracked just off the first flight near the inside racing into the bend but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. COYOTE BREEZE settled outside foes off the second flight early, was fanned six wide into upper stretch and never seriously menaced.
