Footnotes

MOONSHINE STILL took up a position tracking just off the leaders racing nearest the rail in the opening stages, came through close quarters inside foes to challenge nearing upper stretch, wrested a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker and drove clear. SPEEDY MEDIA shifted inwards tracking the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, angled four wide in upper stretch and continued with a steady bid between foes to narrowly prevail for place honors. GOTCHA CART tracked the leaders unhurried three deep between foes racing off the second flight in the opening stages, angled out five wide in upper stretch and continued willingly in that path while just missing for second. PALM SPRINGS joined the pace outside foes from the break, pressed the issue three deep to upper stretch and weakened between foes late. DOUGHNUT MAN was urged to the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command between foes on the turn to upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker. BALTIC VERSE tracked the leaders off the second flight along the inside early but never gained contention. KING AJAX tracked between foes off the second flight racing into the bend but couldn't produce a closing response. STRONG STAG was never a factor. UNBRIDLED ASCENT, caught in tight quarters at the start, dropped off the pace and never menaced thereafter.
