DANCE FOR PACO was settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening quarter, commenced a sharp advance along the rail racing into the turn, came through close quarters to challenge inside the pacesetter in upper stretch, was crowded a bit by that rival nearing the furlong marker but wrested command and edged clear late under steady handling. MY KRYPTONITE was hustled to the lead soon after the start, angled inside once clear after the opening furlong, set the pace to upper stretch just off the rail, shifted in nearing midstretch while making light contact with the eventual winner disputing the issue but proved no match late. FEAR NOR FAVOR settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the turn gathering momentum, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to earn a share despite the loss of his rider's whip. GO POSSE GO, a bit slow into stride, raced well off the field into the bend, then made an effort to improve position inside foes late. MARITIME MAN, urged to secure a position along the inside early, tracked the pacesetter inside foes into the bend, shifted out in upper stretch but steadily faded nearing the furlong marker. C SAGA RYDER was a bit outpaced early, angled six wide racing into upper stretch, exchanged contact with RUN NICKIE RUN and had no further response while passing some tiring foes. MADILLAC D'VILLE tracked off the second flight near the inside racing to the turn and steadily retreated from contention. RUN NICKIE RUN swerved a bit at the start, was urged to position between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, then lost all momentum after exchanging bumps with C SAGA RYDER. R. CAMPFIRE tracked off the second flight outside foes early and never mounted a serious challenge. NO MORE TALKIN was urged to gain a position three wide in the second flight in the opening stages but dropped out early.
