Footnotes

BRAIN TEAZE ducked inwards at the start, was steadied momentarily off rivals just after the break, was urged to split foes three deep joining the pace in the opening furlong, pressed the pace outside a rival while being floated out nearing upper stretch, was roused to wrest command while shifting inwards nearing midstretch and drew clear racing along the rail under steady pressure. DANCINGSONOFAGUN, caught in tight quarters at the start, was urged between foes to dispute the pace racing well off the inside into the turn, dueled into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. GOLDEN PURGE, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening stages, tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight, shifted outside that foe entering upper stretch and continued evenly for a share. PEYTONVILLE settled between foes well off the second flight, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and improved his position. DO DAT TUNE tracked just off the leaders four deep early, angled inwards after a half to race near the inside into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. LITTLE WHISKEY settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. ANIMATER ducked inwards at the gap and soon trailed.
