Footnotes

J. Z.'S CRAFTY BOY was urged to gain a forward placing outside foes in the opening stages racing just off the pacesetter, moved to force the issue racing into the turn while remaining a bit off the rail, edged forward to a narrow advantage nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. MR. SWAGGER, reserved in hand while racing in close quarters in the opening stages tracking just off the first flight, was bumped midway through the backstretch, continued in close quarters to the turn, shifted off the inside racing into upper stretch, angled out five wide racing through the lane and found his best stride in the closing stages to close the gap while prevailing for place honors. THINKING SHOWBIZ, held up just off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, was urged to bid between rivals racing through the turn, couldn't match the winner's pace entering upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages while earning a share. LAST GUN IN TEXAS broke inwards brushing a rival at the start, was urged to the lead while angling to the inside in the opening quarter, disputed the issue nearest the rail into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. PUMPKIN PUSHER, bumped soon after the break while racing in hand early, was bumped, then squeezed between foes racing through the backstretch, steadied out of tight quarters nearing the bend, shifted out racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. LAFTER EVER AFTER shifted inwards under pressure bumping PUMPKIN PUSHER in the opening stages, continued to exchange contact with that foe while forcing him into a rival's path racing to the turn, angled wide racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. JACK THE LAD briefly pursued the leaders racing four wide into the turn and gave way after a half.
