TWIST OF SILVER was urged through close quarters racing into the first turn to press the pace along the rail, gained a narrow advantage midway through the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn, edged away to a clear advantage in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. BERRY KNOLL, held up just off the first flight racing four deep to the backstretch, continued under some reserve to the second bend, was urged to advance racing four wide into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors in the closing stages. CROSS EYED MARY went up to force the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, conceded the lead midway through the backstretch to attend a rival's pace on her own courage, was urged to force the issue outside that foe racing into the far turn but couldn't match that rival entering upper stretch while continuing well enough to earn a share. ITALIAN ROSE, in touch with the first flight three deep between foes racing to the backstretch, was urged to lodge a brief bid in that path racing through the far turn but steadily faded in the drive. RICO'S POSSE angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders under rating in the opening half, saved ground through the far turn but lacked the needed closing response. IRISH DIXIE, reserved just out of striking distance while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, was caught five wide midway through the backstretch and soon dropped out of contention.
