Footnotes

HURTA was urged to secure a narrow advantage along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, turned back several challengers to maintain the lead into upper stretch and edged clear in late stages under steady handling. CALL TO GLORY, urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner but held a rival for place honors. SWEETEST RHYTHM took up a forward placing three deep racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue in that path racing into the far turn, couldn't match the winner and was outfinished for second. COURTLY settled just out of striking distance off the inside in the opening half, shifted out four wide racing through the far turn but had no closing response. TSUNAMI KING was settled outside a rival racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. RIVER OF NO RETURN, held up just off the first flight along the inside racing to the far turn, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
