DUSTINCASE, bumped at the start, was quickly righted while shifting outside the pacesetter to gain a stalking position, rated off that foe racing into the bend, commenced a steady advance nearing upper stretch to wrest command at the furlong marker and drew away late under firm encouragement. COME ON MAN was urged to secure the lead from the outset while remaining off the inside in the opening stages, set the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. CAPTAIN JACK, held up between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, continued evenly into the stretch while earning a share. GHETTO CAT tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to advance racing four wide into the turn, steadied a bit when altering course in traffic entering upper stretch and had no closing response. POWERFUL ZEN settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. DECOMMANDER broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, shifted to the rail in the opening stages to track just off the pacesetter racing into the turn but retreated from contention early. BIG BAD MIKE tracked off the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted out five wide racing into the turn and never seriously menaced. HART OF A COWBOY, reserved along the inside racing into the turn, offered no rally.
