MARKREE BREEZE exchanged bumps with PROUD PICK at the start, was righted to gain a position three wide racing just off the second flight in the opening quarter, commenced a steady advance to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command midstretch and just held the challenge of BONNIE to the end under firm encouragement. The latter, allowed to settle in last along the inside racing to the bend, gained some momentum in upper stretch, split foes near the inside to bid inside the leader in the final sixteenth and was going well late to just miss. SHO BIZ SREVA, urged to position in the second flight racing outside a rival in the opening stages, chased the pacesetter between foes through the turn but had no final response. FLOR MORENA broke sharply, shifted to the inside setting the pace racing into the turn, held sway to upper stretch but faltered once headed by the winner. PROUD PICK exchanged bumps with the eventual winner at the start, was collected to track off and outside the second flight under reserve racing to the turn and lacked a closing response. THATTHINGOFEP stalked just off the pacesetter along the rail in the opening quarter but came up empty after a half and gave way entering upper stretch.
