**Footnotes**

JEANNIEDUBAI broke readily, was rated outside foes in the second flight while maintaining striking position racing to the turn, advanced three deep between foes to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, wrested command approaching the furlong marker and drew clear under pressure and a few right handed taps. CASHA, steadied a bit in close quarters at the break, was urged to secure the lead along the inside in the opening furlong, shook clear nearing upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. SWEET CHARISE, pinched back at the start, settled off the second flight, shifted out racing into the turn, angled five wide entering upper stretch gathering momentum and continued willingly in that path to the end to prevail for a share. ELUSIVE SILVER tracked the leaders five deep off the second flight in the opening quarter, angled inwards on the turn and continued evenly three deep between foes to late stages while making an effort to improve her placing. ANNIE'SYANK tracked just off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, was urged to advance in that path racing through the turn, moved to challenge nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. DEBINATOR broke outwards crossing the path of CASHA, was urged along the rail in pursuit of the leaders racing into the turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. A DINK A DINK A DO broke inwards impeding SWEET CHARISE, was settled into stride along the rail racing to the turn and never gained contention. REMINDER was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival from the break and gave way after a half.
