TOTAL IMMERSION was urged to join the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, steadily pressed the issue on the turn into upper stretch, gained a clear advantage nearing the furlong marker and extended the advantage under brisk handling. CHAMPAGNE TONY gained a position outside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, continued with a steady advance to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. GEORGIE MY BOY broke sharply, was urged to dispute the pace while shifting to the inside racing into the turn, dueled inside the winner to upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker. RADIANT DAY tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing to the end. FLATHEAD RIVER, held up off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, raced three deep into upper stretch and continued evenly in the closing stages. SANCERRE was urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight tracking just off the leaders racing into the turn but quickly came up empty after a half. WINNINGCHEROKEE broke in the air, was settled in last racing to the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. SMOKIN GLOCK was held up between foes tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, continued near the inside on the turn but lacked a closing response. TALL GRASS CAT, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, continued four deep into the turn tracking off the second flight and proved no real threat. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
