Footnotes

NO PASSAGE tracked the leaders along the inside from well out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out entering the bend while making steady progress, drew on terms with the leaders nearing the furlong marker and prevailed in the final stages under steady handling. SMOAKBOX, on terms with a rival on the pace from the outset, attended that foe's tempo under light rating racing into the bend, pressed between foes for command racing through the stretch and was narrowly outfinished. CALABASH secured the lead soon after the start, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail racing into the turn, held sway past the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the top pair late. COLTON D shifted off the inside in the opening stages tracking the leaders from well out of striking distance and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. DERBY NITE settled outside foes in the opening stages and offered no rally. JABBAWOKEE broke slowly, was settled out of tight quarters at the start and trailed the field to the stretch.
