Footnotes

CODE OF KINGS secured a position just off the first flight tracking the leaders under some reserve, came through close quarters entering upper stretch to challenge between foes, then wrested command and edged away under steady handling. SHOTGUN LUKE, in close attendance to the pace three deep early, pressed the pace outside a rival into upper stretch, exchanged some light contact with the eventual winner in upper stretch when challenged by that foe and couldn't quite match terms with that rival in the final furlong while prevailing for place honors. TANK'S LETTER prompted the pace between foes racing into the bend, angled to the rail on the turn continuing to duel for command, held a narrow advantage nearing midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. THERE GOES BEAU BO broke slowly, tracked the leaders well out of striking distance outside a rival racing to the turn and continued evenly off the inside into the stretch. GIRLS CHOICE bobbled at the start, was settled into stride near the inside, then was carried out by HOLY BULLHIVE in upper stretch while failing to menace. HOLY BULLHIVE was urged to dispute the pace racing along the rail into the turn, emptied out early, then drifted out in upper stretch while impeding a rival.
