Footnotes

FACEY'S SPIRIT sprinted clear of her foes along the inside soon after the break, held sway on a clear margin to upper stretch and maintained the advantage to the end under steady pressure. MAUDE S, allowed to settle in last while angling to the inside, steadily gathered momentum nearing upper stretch, shifted out to split foes three deep nearing the furlong marker and continued with a steady late response to close the gap while prevailing for second. CATINATREE broke readily, ceded the lead to a rival to track that foe under light rating racing into the bend, continued with a steady effort into the stretch but was outkicked for place honors. SEANS SILVERDANCER settled into stride while being guided to the rail in the opening furlong, then continued with an even effort inside foes to late stages. ITZACOLDCASE tracked the pace five wide off the second flight racing into the turn but never gained contention. MISSJEANLOUISE tracked the pacesetter four deep in second flight racing into the turn and steadily retreated in upper stretch. TAYLER'S DESTINY tracked the pacesetter three deep between foes in second flight racing to the bend and steadily faded entering upper stretch.
