**Footnotes**

OLD LOW DOWN broke inwards bumping HE'S A BAD BOY, was righted, then urged to join a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo into the bend, asserted himself to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch and held safe the challenge of HOMES THE FACT under firm handling. The latter angled in tracking off the first flight near the inside, made a steady advance to contention while shifting out in upper stretch, closed the gap in late stages but came up second best. HE'S A BAD BOY, bumped at the start, shifted out after the break while tracking off the second flight, then made steady progress four wide into upper stretch to close the gap while earning a share. TRADE DEFICIT, unhurried early in stages, continued evenly between foes while gaining some position. RIO STAR was urged to dispute the pace inside the eventual winner racing into the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. J R'S ADVANTAGE was a brief factor three wide chasing the leaders but was through after a half. JIGAR trailed.
