Footnotes

SEA URCHIN broke inwards, secured a position racing just off the pacesetter along the rail in the opening stages, saved ground awaiting an opening on the far turn, switched out three deep approaching the furlong marker while being roused to challenge and just collared CLASSIC RECITAL in time under steady left handed prompting. The latter angled inwards just after the break to stalk just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, steadily drew on even terms leaving the far turn, edged clear between calls in the final furlong and was just outnoddod on the wire. HAILFELLOW broke sharply, set the pace along the rail into the backstretch, dueled inside a rival for command on the far turn into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. MAGIC MAN broke outwards, was settled well off the leaders, saved ground to upper stretch and passed inside some tiring foes to improve his placing late. EIGHT GAUGE tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, shifted out to make a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. ADDAWAY RAJ, pinched back out of close quarters at the start, was rank while shifting outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled out four wide midway through the backstretch while being urged to contention but steadily faded after six furlongs.
