JALOUX broke inwards brushing SPANISH DEVIL, was hustled clear of her foes while angling over racing into the turn, held sway on a clear margin to the end and was kept to steady pressure. BARI'S PULPETTE, reserved between foes to track off the second flight in the opening stages, was shuffled a bit in close quarters racing through the turn, then split foes three deep racing through the stretch to secure the place honors near the wire. WILDCAT DEVIL, urged to position outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, couldn't close the gap on the winner and finished evenly in late stages while earning a share. SPANISH DEVIL, brushed at the start, recovered to track the leaders three deep behind the second flight, shifted inwards on the bend while being urged to advance but had no final response. SOMALI BYRD was settled outside foes in the opening stages, then shifted out four wide in upper stretch while making an even effort. MAMAMEME settled into stride along the inside early, angled out five wide in upper stretch but made no real impression. DECISIVE ACTION was never a factor. EPPI'S TIGRESS tracked just off the pacesetter inside a rival in second flight racing to the turn but retreated from contention early. ADARA soon trailed.
