#### Footnotes

**DOMINANT SUH** was reserved just off the pace while angling to the rail in the opening stages, continued under patient handling in that position racing into the far turn, shifted out three deep nearing midstretch while being urged to challenge, then wrested command and edged forward under firm handling. **HENDERSON** hopped at the start, angled to the inside tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out nearing midstretch and split foes in late stages to prevail for second. **SAHM LIKE IT HOT** moved to secure a forward placing stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed that foe racing through the far turn but flattened out leaving midstretch. **HERE COMES HENRY** broke inwards bumping **HE'S GOT TO RUN**, was held up between foes just off the second flight racing into the far turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance but finished evenly in late stages. **HE'S GOT TO RUN**, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to gain the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged on the far turn but weakened leaving midstretch. **SCORE BABY SCORE** tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. **HIP HOPPER** was settled into stride off the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. **JACOB'S LIGHTHOUSE** tracked just off the leaders three deep in the second flight for a half but steadily faded racing through the far turn.
