Footnotes

TRUEBILL was guided to the inside early tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, made a steady advance along the rail to challenge inside the leader leaving midstretch and prevailed in time under firm right handed encouragement. TWELVE HUNDRED joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, shook clear midway through the bend, held sway past midstretch but couldn't quite fend off the winner. HEIR TO DIXIE was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, lost some position to that foe on the bend, shifted out in upper stretch and was making a solid second effort to close the gap late. RARE COURAGE settled between foes in the opening stages, angled inside racing into the turn and made an effort to improve position. DANDYMAN shifted off the inside tracking the leaders from out of striking distance racing into the bend, angled five wide in upper stretch gaining some position but made no real impression. LITTLE KICK was a brief factor three deep between foes chasing the leaders into the turn but retreated early. MONTANA, urged along four wide tracking just off the leaders racing into the turn, emptied out after a half. ROSES PLUS raced a bit erratically between foes in the opening stages and quickly dropped out. LITTLE SLEW MOON raced outside foes off the second flight but dropped out early.
