Footnotes

BONITA BETS was urged to gain a position outside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted in nearing the turn while pursuing the pacesetter in tandem with several rivals, bid for command between foes after a half and edged clear racing through the stretch under firm handling. J'S HONOR swerved outwards crossing the path of ANYONESHOME and bumping TAKE MANHATTAN soundly, continued to shift out while being urged to contention racing into the turn three deep between foes, eased off the second flight entering the bend, shifted four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged again to advance and continued with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. TAKE MANHATTAN, bumped soundly, then checked between foes at the start, settled into stride racing into the bend, split foes three wide racing through the stretch and continued willingly to late stages to prevail for a share. BOB'S HILDA was hustled to the lead from the outset while angling to the inside, set the pace to upper stretch while briefly resisting the winner but weakened leaving the furlong marker. PASSPOST TO PARIS broke inwards bumping WILD STORY, then steadied off foes, was urged along four wide to gain a position in the second flight, shifted in entering the turn to press the issue three deep into upper stretch but drifted out and soon gave way. SARA'S GOLDMINE, bumped from both sides and squeezed at the start, recovered to gain a position off the second flight while being shuffled a bit after the opening furlong, shifted five wide racing into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch but had no further response. ANYONESHOME broke slowly and never gained contention. APTITUDE IN ME tracked just off the first flight near the inside racing into the bend but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. WILD STORY, bumped at the start, trailed throughout. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START AND

DISQUALIFIED J'S HONOR FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM SIXTH.
