KOTTOPOULA raced three wide near the middle of the field and lacked a winning bid. TOO MANY LIES lacked speed and was not a factor. DEPUTY TICE was pinballed at the start and was always outrun. MANEKE was bumped at the start, raced close up off the rail and gave way.
