Footnotes

B B'S BEST BET, bumped soundly at the start by SWIFTY'S PLACE, quickly recovered to join the first flight between foes, was eased off the leaders midway through the backstretch to track just off the first flight, split foes three wide to challenge nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with WINDY CITY LEAL nearing midstretch while gaining some cover from that foe and just edged that rival on the wire under strong handling. The latter broke out, bumped LUCKY PINS, was quickly righted to press the pace three between foes racing into the bend, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch and just yielded to the winner in the final strides while feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. SWIFTY'S PLACE, bumped soundly at the start by ELECTRIC STRIDE and forced into the path of the winner, was collected to track the leaders in hand while off the inside, then switched out five wide in upper stretch and steadily improved his placing. JADE MAN, off a step slowly, was hustled along the rail to contend with the first flight racing into the bend and gave way in upper stretch. LUCKY PINS, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to join the pace five wide early, continued to dispute the issue four wide on the bend, then gave way in upper stretch. SECURITY BLANKET was reserved out of close quarters just after the start, raced unhurried along the inside and soon dropped out. ELECTRIC STRIDE veered out, bumped SWIFTY'S PLACE soundly at the start, was quickly collected to duel for command between foes but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
