MOLANDER, prominent along the inside just after the break, was held up off a rival entering the first turn to track that foe from just out of striking distance in the opening half, commenced a steady advance on the leader nearing upper stretch, wrested command from that rival nearing midstretch, went clear and held sway to the end, drifting out in the final stages while feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. HOLD'EM TIGER was hustled clear racing into the first turn, set the pace into the second bend, proved no match when confronted by the winner but continued willingly to prove best of the others. ADVANCED SIGNS raced a bit erratically along the inside in early stages tracking the pace unhurried, then came inside foes to gain a share in the last furlong, making the most of a ground saving trip. JOY FROM PHOENIX tracked the leaders racing three wide between foes in the opening half but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. RAILSPLITTER was caught four wide racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced. RIO ROYALE, off slowly, tracked the leaders along the inside, made a brief bid just off the inside nearing upper stretch but steadily faded in the drive. AMERIHEART, reserved in hand racing off the inside in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge.
