Footnotes

DANIEL'S MAGIC exchanged bumps with WEEKENED PASS at the start, was collected and guided immediately to the rail, moved inside foes to gain striking distance along the inside entering the far turn, shifted out to race between foes leaving the midway point of the second bend, was carried out a bit by THE WRECKER leaving the quarter mile marker, but continued resolutely three deep in the lane to wrest command from INVISIBLE STAR in late stages, prevailing under firm encouragement. The latter angled inwards while gaining a forward placing racing into the first bend, attended a rival's pace for a half, pressed the issue on the far turn to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. THE WRECKER went readily to the fore, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn, drifted out when losing terms with the pacesetter entering upper stretch and weakened in late stages, drifting outwards while feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. WEEKEND PASS exchanged bumps with the winner at the start, was righted to take up a tracking position racing four deep into the backstretch, drew into striking distance while being fanned five wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. CRIMINALLY INSILVER was reserved just off the inside in the opening half but came up empty when called upon to advance racing through the far turn. SEAMANS VILLAGE, unhurried between foes off the inside racing to the backstretch, dropped out of contention early. CART'S SLEW tracked just off the first flight racing three wide to the backstretch, briefly menaced in that path on the far turn, then emptied out in upper stretch.
