Footnotes

FLY DRAGONFLY, reserved tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, commenced a steady advance entering the bend, wrested command nearing midstretch and edged clear under brisk right handed encouragement. ULTERIOR MOTIVE was urged clear along the inside from the outset, dictated the pace into the bend, couldn't fend off the winner when challenged by that foe but proved best of the others. MADILLAC D'VILLE tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight, angled inwards on the turn and continued to make mild progress to late stages while shifting outside the leaders racing through the stretch. TAOS RIDGE was guided to the rail early while settling well off the pace, shifted outside a rival racing into the turn to gain some position but never gained contention. SCHAEFER never seriously menaced. HOWARD WHO broke outwards, was righted to chase the pace between foes into the bend but emptied out early. JOSIES DISTRACTION was a brief factor three wide between foes racing to the turn but steadily retreated after a half.
