Footnotes

CANDY VAN CAN, held up just off and outside the first flight in the opening quarter, was urged to challenge four deep nearing upper stretch, continued in that path to gain a narrow advantage approaching the furlong marker, then held safe the challenge of STAR RATING to the end under steady left handed encouragement. The latter was guided to the inside in the opening stages while firmly rated just off the first flight, saved ground to upper stretch, came through when presented an opening in upper stretch to challenge for command, pressed the winner to the end but couldn't quite match terms with that foe. CLYDE BANK was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, attended the pace to the bend, pressed between foes into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair but continued with interest to gain a share. A NICE SLEWISH BOY was settled four deep between foes in the opening quarter, shifted out four deep in upper stretch and continued evenly outside foes. KING OF CANDYLAND moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the turn, dueled for command on the bend, shifted out a bit entering upper stretch and gave way. HIP HOPPER broke a bit slowly, tracked the leaders as part of the last flight along the inside racing to the turn but offered no rally. ARICAT, reserved five deep in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge.
