Footnotes

MILLIONAIRE STORM, prominent between foes in the opening stages, was urged to gain a narrow advantage between calls racing into the turn, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival to late stages and edged that foe under firm handling. TOTE, urged to join the pace three deep after the opening furlong, pressed the issue outside the winner to late stages but was just outfinished. KENTUCKY BOURBON, urged to dispute the pace inside rivals racing into the bend, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. DAKOTA COUNCIL, bumped at the start, settled between foes in early stages and continued with a steady response to improve position. MAD ABOUT ALLI tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn but offered no rally. NINE SIXTEEN shifted off the inside racing in the last flight early, was held up when avoiding tight quarters nearing the bend and lacked a further response. SHERIFF BART, a bit outpaced early despite some prompting, never seriously menaced. K. O. THE MAN shifted out four wide early while being urged to gain contention racing into the bend but steadily faded nearing the lane.
