STEPHEN'S TRUTH broke readily, shifted off the inside disputing the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, drifted out leaving the quarter mile marker bumping NELYN'S FLYER while taking a few awkward steps, was righted to maintain the advantage past midstretch and held the late challenge of BRAVA GENIUS to prevail under firm encouragement. The latter, in touch with the first flight between rivals early, was forced to alter course to the inside avoiding close quarters racing into the bend, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance to upper stretch but continued willingly along the rail in late stages to close the gap on the winner. NELYN'S FLYER joined the pace outside the eventual winner soon after the start, pressed that rival while racing well off the inside into the turn, was bumped by the leader leaving the quarter mile marker and soon gave way. STING AGAIN, reluctant to load in the starting gate, tracked just off the first flight racing four wide into the bend, then continued evenly in that path to late stages. BEAUTIFUL SCORE settled into stride along the inside early, angled five wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. FIELD HOUSE tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the turn but offered no rally. JENNIFER LOVES ED broke slowly and never gained contention. ROOM FOR APTITUDE tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, lost position while going a bit erratically nearing the furlong marker and was eased up late. ROYAL THUMPURR broke awkwardly and never gained contention. SHAWKLIT PUDDIN, caught five wide racing into the turn, retreated early.
