### Footnotes

CART'S PROMISE stalked the pace, surged clear into stretch and widened thereafter under token pressure. CREOLE'S AFFAIR chased the pace while five wide, angled in for the backstretch run and kept on for a minor share in the stretch. THE VELVET SMOG gained the lead, held well into the stretch, was headed but stayed on. IRON VOW unruly before the start, travelled five wide up the backstretch and lacked finishing punch. WE'RE FOR REAL reserved early, moved five wide into the stretch and made no bid. THREE TICKETS bore out entering the first turn, raced wide throughout and posed no threat. CANARY KID saved ground and offered no contending bid. FLYABOVETHEREST pressed the pace, gained a narrow lead far around the far turn and faltered. PROPER AMERICAN was outrun. SARATOGA BREEZE raced six wide early and was never involved. MOE B WON KNOBE showed brief speed and tired badly.
