STAKES Cryptoclearance S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Nominations close Saturday, March 27, 2010 with no nomination fee. A supplementary nomination may be made at time of entry for \$500 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box. Original nominees that start will receive a \$750 rebate. \$50,000 Guaranteed, with \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs; non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2009-2010, 4 lbs.; non-winners of \$18,600 at a mile or over since September 15, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered.) High weights (including sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights and second parts of same owner entry will receive no consideration over single entries. This Stake will be limited to fourteen starters. In the event of an over-subscribed field, low weighted horses preference will be determined by highest career earnings. Nominations closed Saturday, March 27, 2010 with 20.

Footnotes

SHADOWBDANCING sped to the fore inside foes from the break, dictated the pace near the inside on a clear margin into the far turn and held sway to the end under steady pressure. P D Q KIDDO tracked the pace between foes in second flight, made steady progress racing into the far turn while shifting to the inside, switched outside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch to challenge but was always only second best. MARILYN'S GUY was settled between foes in the opening stages, made some progress while angling to the inside entering the far turn, then continued willingly just off the winner to late stages. PROCEED BEE stalked just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, couldn't gain terms with that foe shifting out three wide leaving the far turn and weakened in the drive. INSTILL was settled along the inside early and never gained contention. TOO MANY SINS raced in close attendance to the pace while three wide early, continued outside foes on the far turn and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. NAVY WINGS, caught four wide in early stages, never seriously menaced. BROTHERS NICHOLAS tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside and dropped out after a half.
