DAD ARE WE HERE was prompted to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued under patient handling tracking just off the leaders in that path racing into the far turn, was urged to challenge for command three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, wrested a narrow advantage and steadily edged clear late under spirited handling. FRANCOIS was rated just out of striking position along the inside in the opening half, shifted out racing into upper stretch, angled four deep nearing the furlong marker while being roused to challenge, couldn't gain even terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. LUV BANDIT, forwardly placed along the rail racing into the first turn, shifted off the inside while maintaining striking distance tracking the pacesetter, was urged to press the leader racing into the far turn, continued to dispute the issue between foes into upper stretch but was outkicked in the final furlong. PLEASANT CLOSING settled into stride while racing off the inside in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but made no real impression. ALL STORMY broke a bit slowly, pulled his way to contention tracking just off the second flight while shifting out four deep on the backstretch, loomed in that path to briefly challenge racing through the far turn but flattened out while being fanned five wide entering upper stretch. HOPE FOR TODAY was hustled to the lead while angling inwards, set the pace on a narrow margin nearest the rail racing into the far turn but gave way racing through upper stretch.
