JIMMY GOT EVEN tracked the pace off the second flight under light reserve while shifting outside foes in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum between foes nearing upper stretch, shifted four deep entering the lane while being roused to challenge, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and just held the late charge of LITTLEBROWNROAD under firm right handed pressure in a determined effort. The latter broke a step slowly while held up out of tight quarters at the start, settled into stride racing well off the second flight in the opening quarter, steadily gathered momentum while shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to close the gap while proving only second best. MERCEDES CLASS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, steadily moved to challenge the leaders while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, continued to dispute the issue between foes in that path past midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. WILDWOOD HEIR hesitated at the start losing position to the field, settled into stride near the inside racing to the turn, angled out six wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to gain position to the end. SPENCERS CHOICE, reserved off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn, split foes gaining some position racing into upper stretch, switched back to the rail nearing the furlong marker and lacked the needed final kick. MOONBLAST was urged to gain a forward placing while being carried inwards a bit in the opening stages, shifted outside the pacesetter nearing the turn while maintaining terms with that foe, pressed the issue on the bend to gain a brief advantage racing into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. MAGNET COVE was outpaced early. ONE FOR BISCUIT tracked the leaders along the inside in the second flight racing into the bend but came up empty after a half. TETON MOTEL sprinted to the lead while angling inside and momentarily crowding MOONBLAST in the opening quarter, dueled inside that foe racing into the turn and was spent after a half.
