Footnotes

OUGHTA BE MINE broke readily to gain a narrow advantage along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside on his own courage racing into the far turn, edged clear racing into upper stretch and steadily widened his margin while drifting out markedly despite firm right handed encouragement. SHOW YOUR FACE, reserved in last while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes after three furlongs, commenced an early move four deep racing into the far turn to gain striking distance after six furlongs but couldn't gain even terms with the winner while proving best of the others. TURNPIKE TOMMY tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening half while under some reserve, was caught five wide racing through the far turn while being urged to advance, continued in that path into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position while prevailing for a share. TIDY UP tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, then continued evenly three deep between foes on the far turn to late stages. QSAR (GER) secured terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, couldn't match terms with that foe racing into the far turn and continued evenly off the inside to late stages. RIVERSIDE RASCAL tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail racing as part of the second flight, made brief progress inside foes to gain striking distance after a half but lacked the needed closing bid. JACK AND MAX lost some position after his rider lost her irons at the start, tracked between foes off the second flight under some reserve racing to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed rally. ROB YOUNG was guided to the inside early tracking off the second flight racing into the backstretch but soon dropped out. BIG BEAR HUG stumbled at the start, settled into stride between foes and never gained contention.
