By subscription of \$75 each, which shall accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 may be made on Saturday, March 29, 2008, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$750 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1 percent to all starters finishing sixth through last, 60 percent of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. Weights, Sunday, March 30, 2008. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. Nominations closed Monday, March 24 with 11.

DISTORTED GROOM grabbed the early lead, edged clear on the turn, was challenged in the stretch, responded and held his stablemate safe. RIVERSON saved ground, hugged the rail through the stretch run and finished willingly. MIGHTY RULE raced forwardly while four wide, continued four wide into the stretch and stayed on. HIGH EXPECTATIONS void of early speed, angled five wide into the stretch and lodged a belated bid. COACH JIMI LEE settled along the inside, angled three wide into the stretch, loomed at the three-sixteenths marker but came up empty. OUT FOR A SPIN stalked the pace but dropped back in the stretch. HE'S HOT SAUCE broke outwardly, was outpaced and made no bid.
