Footnotes

MIDDLESCHOOL MAGIC joined the pace four wide from the outset, pressed outside foes racing into the turn, drew away from. GRAY VISION in upper stretch and extended her margin under steady hand urging. The latter was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, continued to vie for command along the rail racing through the turn but proved only second best. ANGEL DIVINE was held up tracking the first flight from out of striking distance, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to gain a share. PADDY'S PISTOL tracked the pace outside foes in second flight racing into the turn and continued evenly three deep into the stretch. BETWEEN was hustled to contend along the rail soon after the start, steadied out of close quarters nearing the bend, tracked the leaders along the rail to upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. WORTHY MISS dropped out of contention early. GENNYRISK, held up along the inside in the opening stages, never gained contention. NO MORE BETS dueled for command three wide between foes racing into the turn and was spent after a half.
