REAL OBVIOUS, reserved outside foes in the opening furlong, advanced with a sharp move after the opening quarter to gain striking distance three deep on the bend, moved clear entering upper stretch and just held the challenge of MODESTA in late stages under firm encouragement. The latter reserved along inside just off the leaders racing to the bend, lost some position while saving ground off the second flight entering the turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to close the gap on the winner. MYSTERY RIDGE chased the leaders three wide between foes in the opening stages, was shuffled a bit in tight quarters entering the turn and continued evenly in that path to late stages while prevailing for a share. SWEET CHI TOWN was urged between foes after the opening furlong to contest the lead, couldn't match the winner entering upper stretch and weakened late. KNOTTS, forwardly placed near the inside in the opening furlong, chased the leaders along the rail into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch to race between foes but had no final response. CLASSY GHOST, a step slow into stride, was hustled to secure the lead in the opening quarter, dueled for command racing into the turn and emptied out after a half. O SO PRUDENT settled in hand early and offered no rally.
