GARLAND'S SPIRIT broke sharply, moved to the fore along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin and steadily drew clear racing into upper stretch when given his cue, extending his advantage to late stages under pressure. IDEAL ALLUVIAL was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, split foes three deep entering the far turn commencing his advance, made steady progress in that path to upper stretch, couldn't menace the winner but proved best of the others. PAPER MAKER, a bit restless in the gate, broke a bit slowly, raced under light reserve along the inside early, saved ground throughout and made an effort to improve position racing into the stretch while earning a share. ROAD TO WAR, urged to gain a forward placing three deep racing into the first turn, shifted in entering the second bend while lodging a brief bid between rivals but flattened out racing into upper stretch. MAGNA FORTUNA tracked off the first flight outside rivals in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the backstretch and steadily faded from contention nearing the far turn. RIO CHAMA was urged to gain a forward placing between foes tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages but soon emptied out racing through the far turn.
