Footnotes

ALL IN SLEW, never far back, moved to terms with the pacesetter entering the backstretch, attended that foe's pace under light rating, moved to wrest command leaving the far turn and drew clear under steady encouragement. SHORE BREEZE ICON tracked outside the leaders in second flight, advanced to challenge three deep on the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. INSTILL tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, then continued evenly in that fashion into the stretch while edging a rival for a share. CARTOUCHE tracked off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued four wide into upper stretch but had no rally. FACE THE FIRE was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace for a half, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. CINCO ESTRELLA tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, steadily retreated on the far turn.
