LADYOFTHELILLY'S gained a contending position racing just off and outside the first flight while under light reserve in the opening quarter, made steady progress to advance on those foes three deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command after being prompted with a right handed tap and drew clear in ridden out effort. KEEPINGTHEPROMISE, on terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo in the opening stages, pressed between foes into upper stretch but proved only second best. MISCHIEF N MAYHEM broke in the air losing position to the field, angled inside early, then shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch while making an effort to improve position. GRACEN RACEN sped to the fore from the break while angling to the inside, dueled for command through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. BEACH CLUB broke sharply, tracked the leaders along the rail in second flight racing to the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. TANITH hopped at the start, was righted to track the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the bend but lacked a closing response. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION, INTERNAL SPLITS WERE NOT AVAILABLE.
