SLAVIC PRINCESS broke readily to attend the pace three deep in the opening quarter, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into the turn and moved clear under firm hand urging and a few right handed taps. EVERYBODY LIES, reserved off the second flight while angling inwards in the opening stages, split foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to secure place honors. I SEE MAMBO was settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for a share. SHE'S PRIME shifted off the inside early while racing just out of striking distance tracking the first flight, moved to gain some position three deep racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. SPECTACULOUS tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and steadily faded. SHARE THE JOY tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but dropped out early. PECOSA, urged between foes from the break disputing the pace, shifted to the rail entering the turn while dueling with the eventual winner and emptied out after a half when proving no match. JUDY MY DARLING was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the break but stopped abruptly after the opening quarter.
