**Footnotes**

SANDIA CREST bumped by LAKOTA WOLF at the start, was reserved in last while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, gathered momentum nearing upper stretch while swinging out six wide and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under strong handling. VIKING tracked the leaders four wide in the second flight in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance in that path nearing the turn, moved to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, struck the front near the furlong marker but proved no match when confronted by the winner. O'HENNESSY, forwardly placed along the inside while on terms with several foes on the pace, was eased off those foes to stalk along the rail racing into the turn, came through when presented an opening nearing upper stretch to challenge for command but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. TOTAL IMMERSION tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted inwards on the bend, awaited an opening from the quarter mile marker to midstretch and finished evenly in the closing stages once clear. MR NUM NUM broke outwards bumping LAKOTA WOLF, was righted to track the pace three deep between foes in the second flight, angled five wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. GEORGIE MY BOY was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, dueled for command along the inside racing through the turn and gave way leaving midstretch. CHATFIELDS CHAP, close up between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to track those foes between rivals racing into the bend but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. LAKOTA WOLF broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, then was bumped again after the start, settled off the second flight while shifting out five wide, continued in that path into the turn and never seriously menaced. TAXES swerved outwards at the start, was quickly righted to force the pace outside foes racing into the turn and gave way after the loss of his rider's whip near the quarter mile marker.
