Footnotes

KIP BERRIES broke sharply to gain a clear advantage, shifted inwards a bit dictating the pace on her own courage just off the inside racing into the turn, was roused when challenged nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. ZIPPING AWAY, held up between foes in the second flight while racing in some close quarters in the opening stages, shifted outside the pacesetter leaving the turn while being urged to challenge that foe but came up second best. DISTORSIONADA, forwardly placed along the rail stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued in that path to upper stretch and finished willingly while being just outfinished for second. STIVERS SUPRISE was settled between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted to the inside on the turn, then switched out to split foes three wide entering upper stretch while making an effort to improve her placing. SAMARA STREET angled inwards a bit tracking off the second flight racing into the turn, swung six wide entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. MILK DUDETTE broke outwards bumping SILKY SAMI twice after the start, was righted to track off the second flight, continued in that path racing through the turn and offered no rally. LITTLE NIP, urged to gain a position four wide in the second flight racing to the turn, was fanned five wide into upper stretch and steadily faded. ALGONQUIN POSSE angled inwards chasing the pacesetter three deep between foes in the second flight racing into the bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch. SILKY SAMI, bumped soundly at the start, never gained contention. RANSOM ZIP was settled along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge.
