NEWS BULLETIN moved to secure a forward placing while shifting in sharply in the opening stages to race just off the pacesetter, continued with a steady bid to wrest command leaving the midway point of the turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch, drew away from the field under pressure and was visibly sore when returning to be unsaddled. ABACO STORM tracked the pace between foes off the second flight near the inside racing to the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for second while lugging inwards nearing the wire. MARITIME MAN tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight while in hand early, shifted three deep on the turn while moving to challenge the winner after a half but lacked the needed final response and

was carried inwards by ABACO STORM nearing the wire. ARCTIC POINT was urged to gain a position inside a rival in second flight tracking the leaders, came through close quarters then shifted out three deep arcing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but had no final response. CEDAR KEY SUNSET broke outwards bumping DON RICARDO, was collected to track off the second flight racing four deep into the turn and continued evenly in that path to late stages. DON RICARDO, bumped at the start while being forced into DON'T WORRY BOUT IT, was reserved in last collecting his stride, shifted out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position three deep between foes in late stages. SILKEN PRINCE sprinted to the lead while angling sharply to the rail, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and emptied out after a half. DONT WORRY BOUT IT, bumped at the start, settled into stride while racing five wide to the turn and never seriously menaced. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD settled into stride near the inside early and never gained contention. NATIVE NOTEBOOK tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail behind the second flight and never mounted a serious challenge. R. CAMPFIRE was never a factor.
