SUMMER AGAIN gained a forward placing stalking a rival's pace under light reserve racing into the first turn, continued in that fashion to the second bend, readily wrested command racing through the far turn, moved well clear under pressure racing past midstretch and was taken in hand late once the issue was decided. CALL ME CLASSY rated off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch while making an effort to improve position along the rail and held a rival for place honors. SAINT INDEED, reserved near the inside racing to the backstretch, came through some close quarters splitting foes four wide racing through the far turn and continued with interest in that path through the lane to earn a share while missing for second. LIME TRYST tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight in the opening half and came up empty racing between foes through the far turn. COYOTE BREEZE tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, was shuffled out of close quarters racing through the far turn and had no rally. LEWDERHOO settled outside foes in last racing to the backstretch, made some brief progress while caught five wide racing through the far turn but had no final bid. MISS JULIA moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, had no response for the winner's challenge and emptied out racing into upper stretch. SCORPIOBDANCING tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages but soon came up empty entering the far turn.
