Footnotes

LEAL RIDGE, reserved in last along the inside, gathered momentum while shifting outside foes entering the far turn, circled foes five wide racing into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure but produced a steady late response to prevail in time under left handed encouragement. W W DISTINCTION tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, lost some position while shuffled a bit leaving the midway point of the backstretch, shifted off the inside to split foes racing into upper stretch gaining contention, then altered course to bid outside the winner in the closing stages, continuing

willingly to the end to close the gap. MISTER PADDY, held up off the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail entering the far turn while commencing a steady advance, came though inside foes to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. EMMA BABY led the second flight on a narrow margin between foes in the opening stages, shifted out racing in close quarters to split foes three deep racing into the far turn, continued to dispute the issue between foes through the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. REDBONE settled outside foes in the opening stages, was caught five wide midway through the backstretch, continued four wide into the second bend while making a brief advance but steadily faded nearing midstretch. CHARMED N DANGEROUS tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was caught in close quarters four deep entering the far turn but offered no closing bid. C C AND MOONLIGHT settled outside foes racing to the first turn, was caught in close quarters midway through the backstretch but never gained contention. DAKOTA COUNCIL, caught four wide in the second flight racing through the first turn, advanced to challenge for command three deep racing into the far turn, gained a clear advantage after six furlongs but failed to sustain his momentum. ANIMAL HOUR, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch, steadily faded between foes racing through the far turn. SEVENTYTWO joined the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch and emptied out abruptly after a half.
