Footnotes

RECTOR stalked just off the pacesetter along the inside on the first turn, steadied off that rival entering the backstretch, switched out nearing the far turn, pressed the leader on the second bend, then wrested command from that foe in the last furlong under firm right handed prompting. HOUSE OF USHER broke readily, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn, resisted the winner to midstretch but came up second best. BADGER BO tracked the pace unhurried just off the second flight racing between foes, shifted inside on the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch, then continued evenly to late stages while earning a share. UNBRIDLED VICAR reserved along the inside in the opening half, saved some ground to upper stretch and improved his position in late stages. OCEAN ACE, reserved in hand while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, tracked outside foes to the far turn, was fanned five wide in upper stretch and had no rally. FREE COUNTRY, caught four wide racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but soon flattened out. LAST DEMAND held up out of close quarters racing into the first turn, never mounted a serious challenge. ROYALTY OF DUBAI was urged to secure a forward placing racing three wide on the first turn, tracked off the pacesetter for a half and gave way on the far turn.
