Footnotes

BALLYGAWLEY, prominent three deep between foes from the outset while attending the pace, moved to command in that path racing through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch remaining well off the inside and held sway to the end under pressure. MISS PALATINE, reserved off the field in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum while racing just outside a rival into the stretch, altered course to the four path nearing the sixteenth marker and continued well enough to secure place honors. SHARP TRIP joined the pace four deep from the break, pressed the issue racing into the turn, continued three deep into upper stretch but weakened in late stages while prevailing for a share. GAIL'S JEWEL tracked off the first flight from just out of striking distance under light reserve early, shifted in nearing the bend and continued evenly between foes in the final quarter. SAMI'S IN TROUBLE was hustled to dispute the pace inside foes in the opening quarter, pressed inside foes on the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. SHAYLINS DANCER was a brief factor tracking off the first flight along the inside but steadily faded on the turn. AWEEOINEINTHEBUNKER, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening stages, pressed the pace racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch.
