### Footnotes

HURRICANE KATIE held up near the inside stalking just off the the pacesetter in tandem with a rival in the opening half, advanced through close quarters to challenge between foes midway through the far turn, shifted to the rail racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to edge forward late under pressure. I TURNED OUTLAW was rated just off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn, shifted out a bit racing into upper stretch carrying out ELECTRIC BOAT slightly, continued to dispute the issue past midstretch but couldn't match terms with the winner late. ELECTRIC BOAT settled last in the opening half, shifted out four wide entering the far turn making a sharp move to contention, was fanned wide racing into upper stretch and failed to match the top pair late. COUNTRY CAUCUS stalked just off the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening stages, advanced to press the issue racing into the far turn but gave way racing into upper stretch. BOB'S HILDA sped to the fore along the inside, set the pace on a comfortable margin for a half but emptied out abruptly once she was headed on the far turn.
