Footnotes

STRAPPING gained terms with a rival on the pace attending that's foe tempo after the opening furlong, pressed the issue through the turn, drew clear in upper stretch and extended the margin to the end under firm encouragement. CHEROBEN rated off the first flight four wide in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention after a half while shifting out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to prevail for place honors. LA PINATA broke sharply, pressed the pace along the rail racing into the turn and gave way leaving midstretch. JACKSONBURG, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, settled outside foes racing to the turn, shifted out five deep racing into the stretch and made an effort to improve position. LARRY ZIP IT angled inwards to track just off the first flight three deep racing into the bend but steadily faded after a half. CAPTAIN LUKE tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages but offered no closing bid. THORSON settled between foes off the second flight in the opening stages but dropped out of contention early.
