Gaelic Breeze moved to the fore entering the first turn while shifting to the rail, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin through the backstretch, forged clear leaving the midway point of the far turn and extended his advantage to the end under pressure. Homes the Fact, held up in close quarters in the opening stages tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, led the second flight on a narrow margin from just out of striking distance racing to the far turn, was urged along in pursuit of the pacesetter into upper stretch but made no impression on that foe while proving clearly best of the others. Lakota Wolf, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening stages, tracked the leaders along the inside racing to the far turn but had no closing bid. C. C. Banjo was rated off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch but lacked the needed closing response. Premeditated tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, made brief progress three deep racing into the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. Pula Pula was never a factor.
